

INSPIRE HOPE - HELP TRAVIS

On June 28th, 2003, one of Dive N' Surf's and Body Glove's family suffered an unimaginable tragedy.

Travis Robinson, the 19-year-old son of John "Jocko" Robinson- an icon in Southern California Diving, employee and friend for over 30 years- broke his neck. He was going to do a belly flop into a friend's pool in Oregon, but at the last moment he shifted his body into a tuck. But it was too late. He entered the water with his neck in the wrong position. It changed his life forever.



Today, Travis is paralyzed from the neck down and is confined to a wheelchair. He requires constant attention. Travis might not be a varsity football player again, or go SCUBA diving with his dad, but technology and recent new research has given victims of severe spinal cord injuries like Travis, new HOPE.

For over 30 years, Jocko has been helping the SCUBA diving community. Now, it's our turn to help Travis and the Robinson Family and INSPIRE HOPE.
